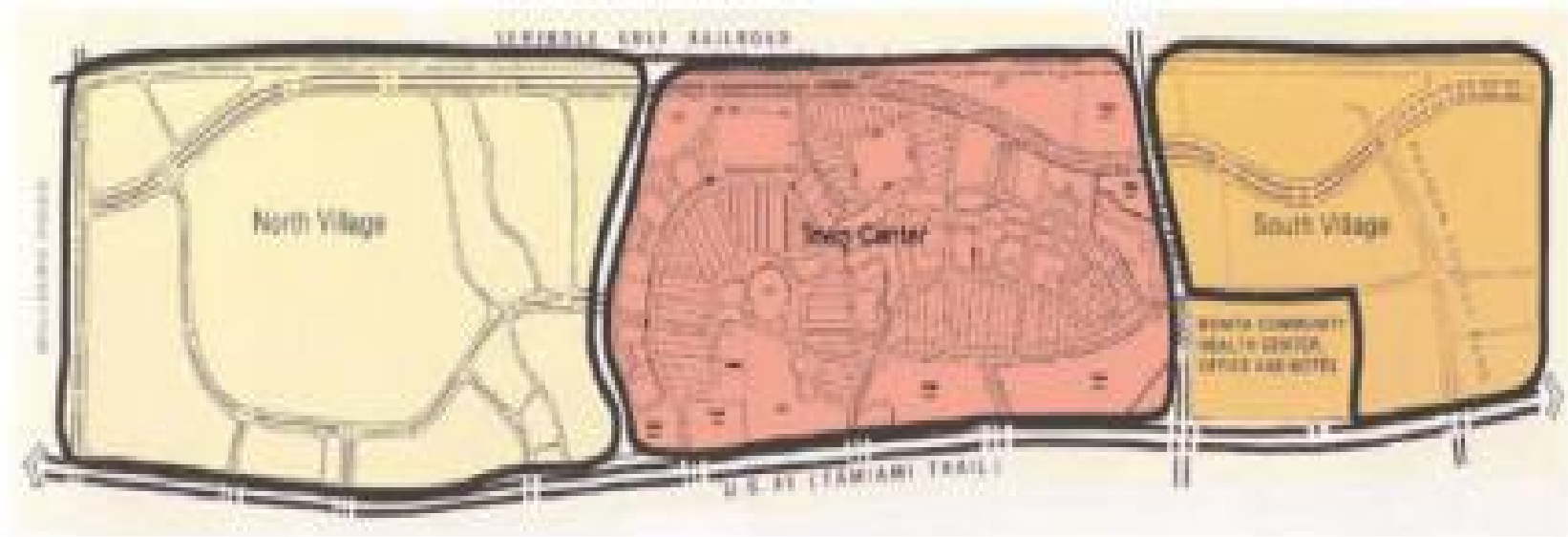

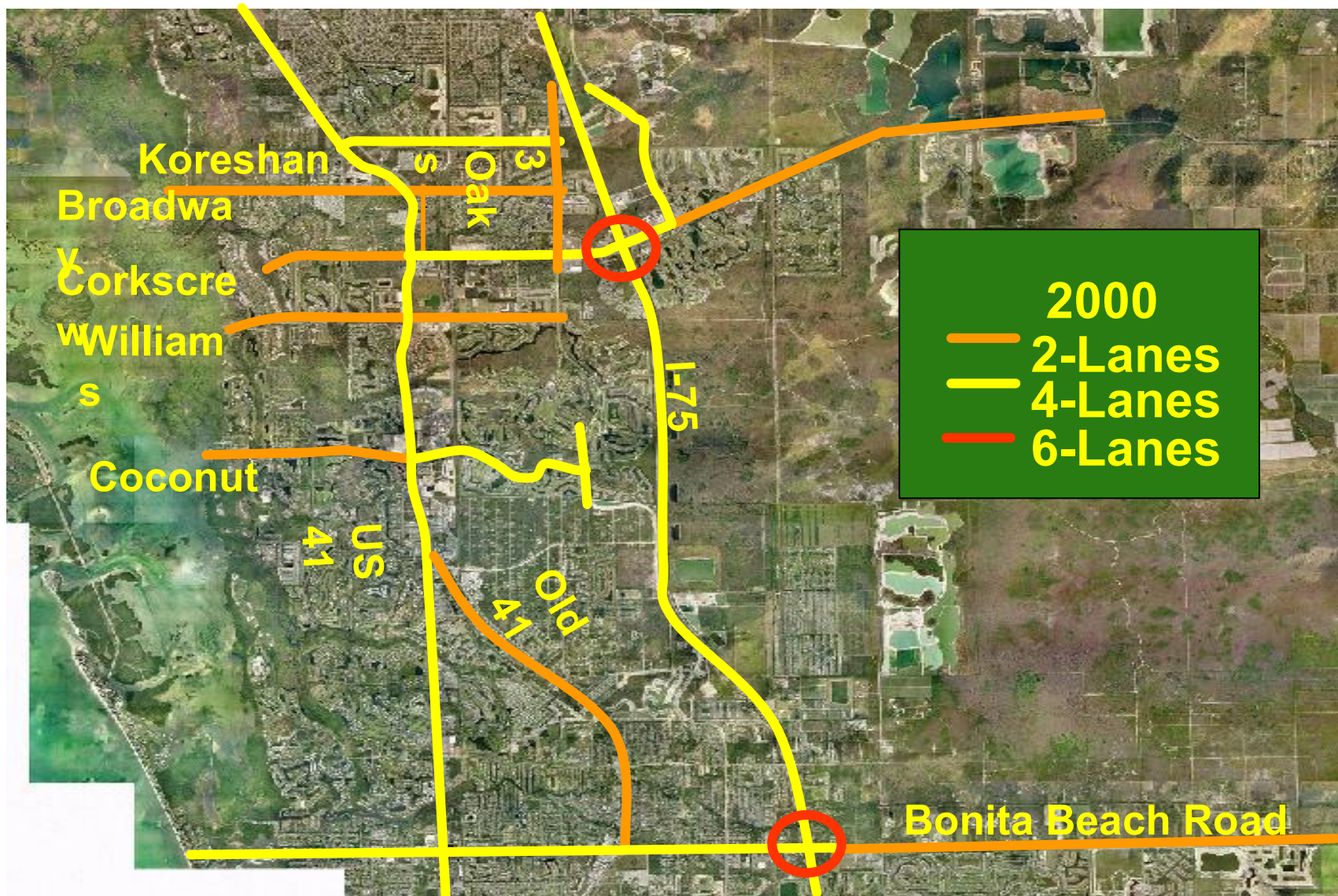

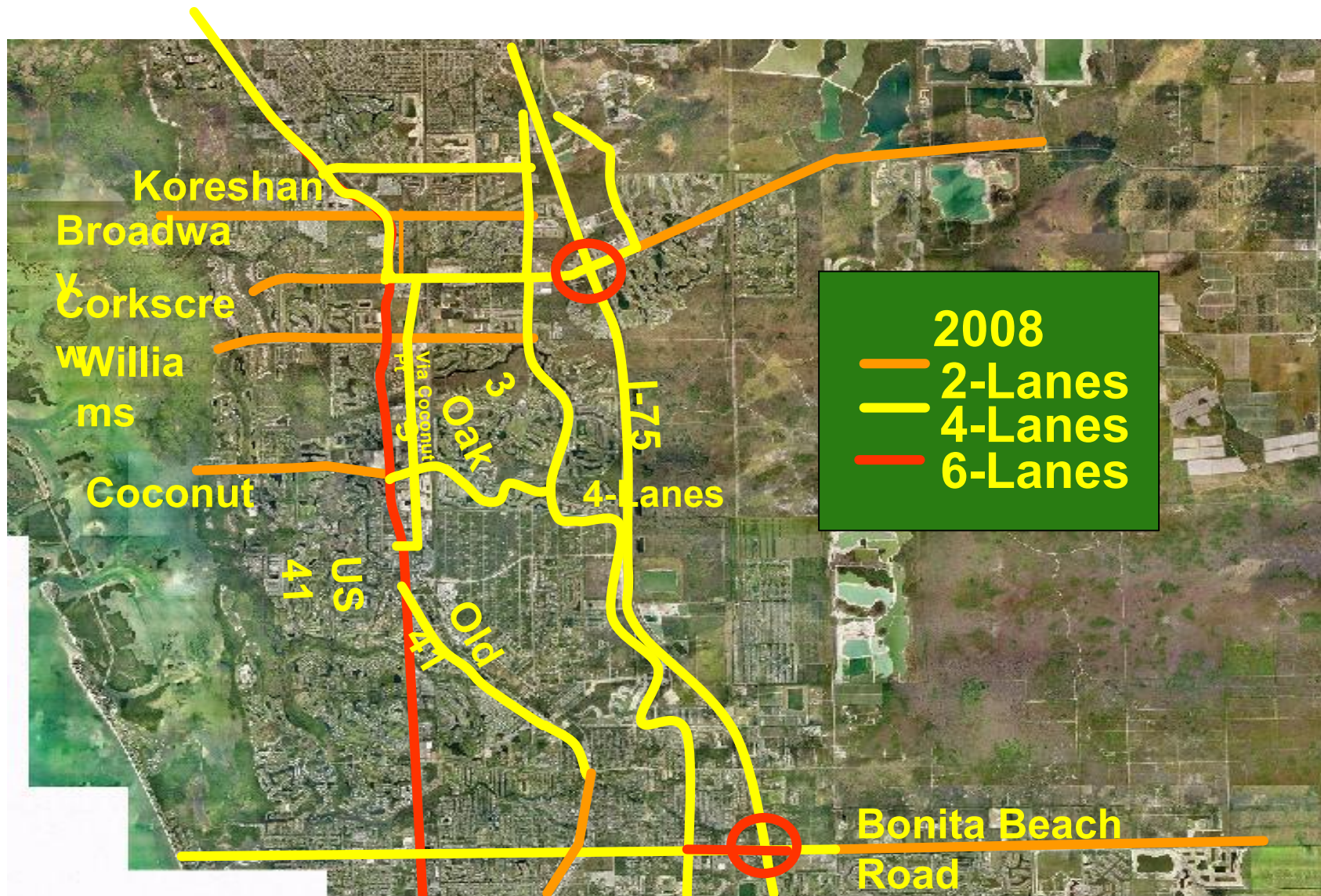

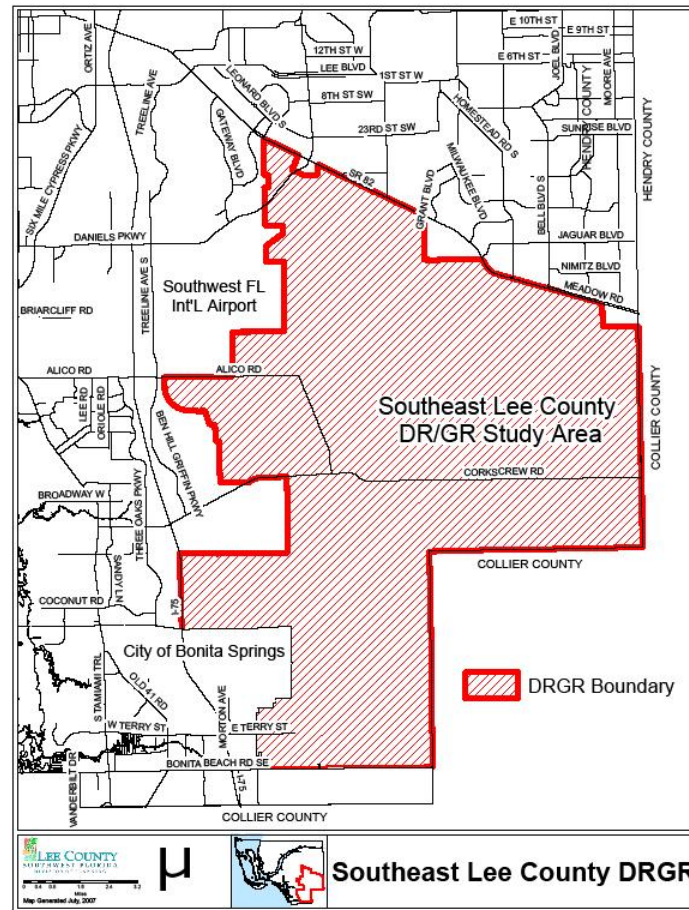

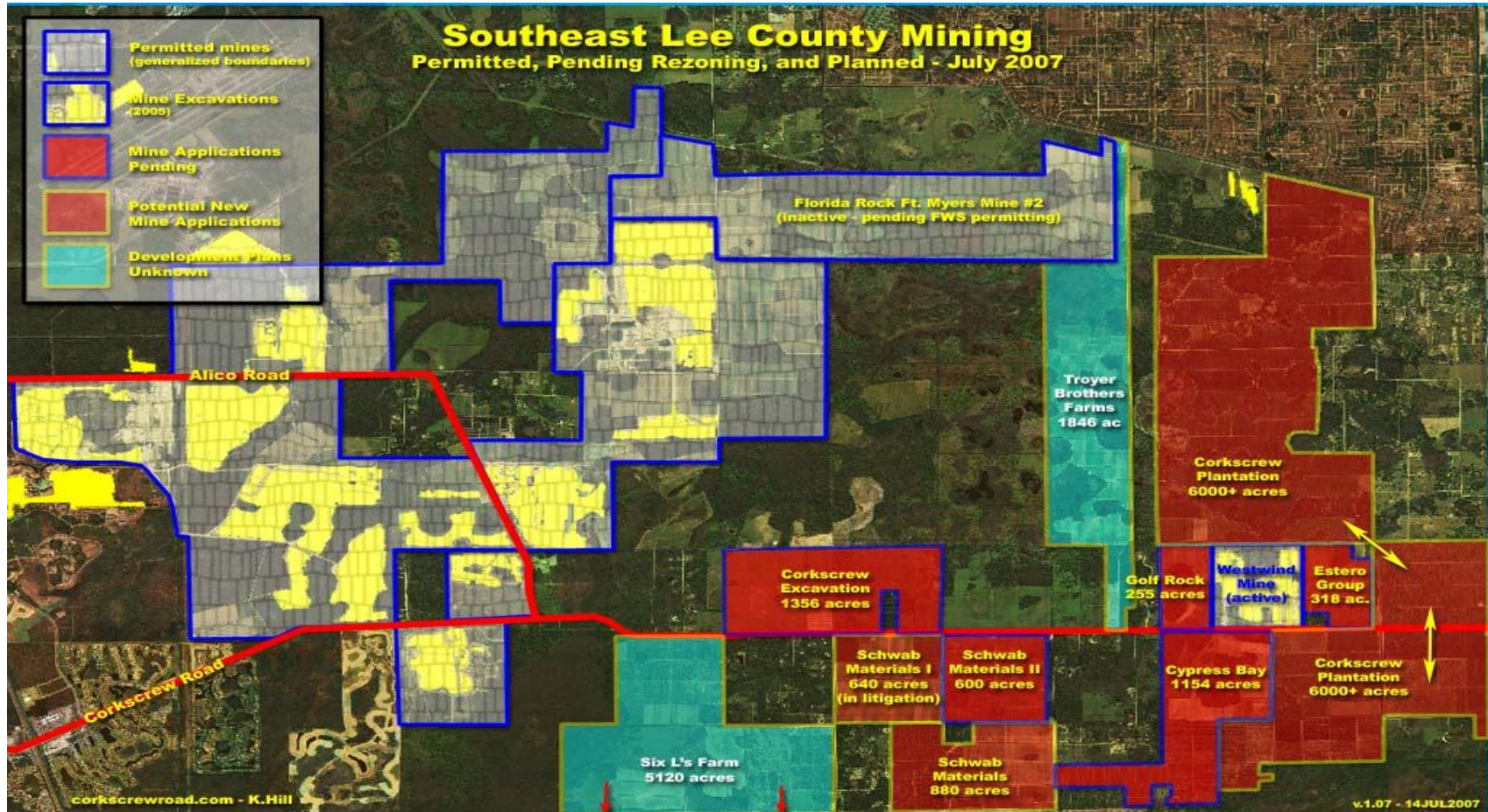

Is There A Need for New Mines?

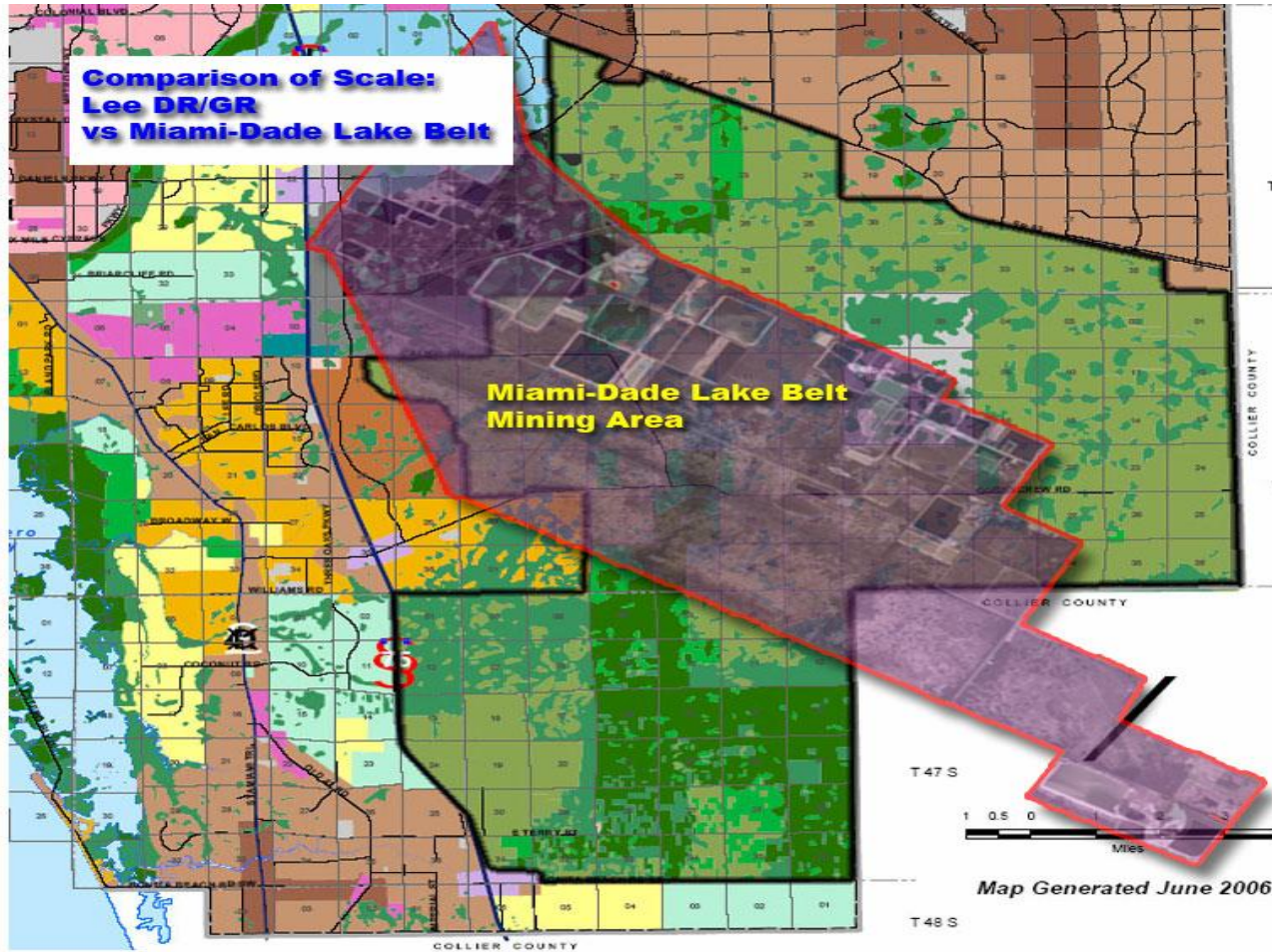
- "The County has zoned 15,475 acres for mineral extraction. The Division of Zoning and Development Review estimates that, at the current annual rate of excavation of 4.42 million cubic yards, the county's approved mining operations will meet its needs for the next 73 years."

Is There A Need for More New Mines?

- In 2002, a total of **5,500** acres of land had been mined in Lee County.
- In the last 5 years acreage has nearly doubled: **5,000 additional** acres permitted for mines.
- Today, applications to approve mining activities on more than **3,000 additional** acres are being reviewed by the County.
- Other DR/GR landowners have declared their intent to mine more than **13,000 additional** acres.
