Plans were submitted for a parking lot with few structures such as a composting toilet, sign kiosk, and a possible open air picnic shelter. The proposed location is along Broadway directly across from Porthole Court.

Conclusions:

- Suggest green metal roofs similar to the existing kiosk for all structures.
- Suggest minimal lot clearing and recommend using the proposed landscape planting in the front (south side) of the parking and along the retention area (south & southeast side).
