



Why You Should Vote in the August 24th Primary?

Lee County, your local government, is governed by a five member Board. Because of Commissioner Bob Janes's death earlier this year, three of the five Board members will be elected this year, most likely in the Republican Primary on August 24th.

Whatever your party preference please request an absentee ballot for this election now so that you can complete it in time to get it back to the Supervisor of Elections prior to election day.



How to Vote Absentee on August 24th

Voting by absentee in Florida is very easy.

- All persons registered to vote in Lee County can apply for an absentee ballot immediately.
- One member of the family can request an absentee ballot for the other voters in the immediate family.
- You may request absentee ballots for the General Election as well.
